1. Review and approve meeting minutes from the March 28, 2022, committee meeting.  
**The minutes were approved.**
2. Review action items from the 3/28/22 minutes.
  - Brian Browning will follow up with Chris Cimino about how the Baker Center intends to use the Honors Program space as well as the anticipated timeline.  
**Brian reported that Marianne Wanamaker is preparing a response to this request.**
  - Holly Raynor will notify appropriate units regarding a transfer of space from Nutrition to RHTM.  
**This item was completed.**
  - Sarah Hoel will notify EHS regarding their request for space in East Stadium Hall.  
**This item was completed.**
  - Jennifer Hardy and Betsy Adams will notify appropriate stakeholders regarding the approval for the Haslam College of Business to assume responsibility for the first-floor classrooms in the Haslam Business Building.  
**This item was completed.**
3. Review a request from the College of Arts & Sciences to permanently assign Claxton rooms 123 and 126 to Modern Foreign Languages and Literatures.  
**The committee approved this request; the assignment will take effect sometime during Summer 2022. Larry McKay will notify MFL.**
4. Review a request from the College of Arts & Sciences to temporarily relocate Africana Studies and English to vacant spaces in Perkins Hall during renovations to the 12<sup>th</sup> floor of McClung Tower, which is anticipated to begin in the fall of 2022.

5. Review a request from the NAGPRA department for space in the Middlebrook Pike Building.

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6. Review a space transfer proposal between Microbiology (College of Arts & Sciences) and Nutrition (College of Education, Health, & Human Sciences) involving rooms 541E, 541E1, 527, 641E, 625, 625A, and 627 in the Mossman Building.

**The committee approved the following assignments. Larry McKay and Hollie Raynor will notify the corresponding units.**

- **Nutrition will be assigned 541E, 541E1, and half of 527**

7. Informational Item Only: Updates on summer 2022 projects and future new building projects.

- **The Energy & Environmental Science Research Building on the AG campus is underway and the substantial completion projection date is some time at the end of calendar year 2024.**
- **The Vet Med Teaching and Learning Center is estimated to be completed later this year.**
- **The pedestrian mall extension just past Pat Summitt up to 20<sup>th</sup> Street has had some delays, but is expected to be completed by the end of May.**
- **The Andy Holt Tower parking lot will be repaved this summer.**
- **New projects on the horizon:**
  - **New Nursing Building: utility work to begin summer of 2022**
  - **New Business Building: design work to begin this fall and the project will encompass the Dunford, Greve, and Henson locations**
  - **New Melrose Building: design work to begin this fall**
  - **Presidential Court Building: design work to begin soon**
