- 1. Review and approval of the 8/29/22 meeting minutes.
- 2. Review of the 8/29/22 meeting action items.
 - During review of the action items, a motion was made, seconded, and approved to reassign the Honors
 Program space to the Baker Center. This approval is conditional on Honors being relocated to their surge
 space and Honors will continue use of the lounge through the spring 2023 semester. Sarah Hoel will
 notify the Baker Center.
 - Dr. McKay will notify Math of the approval to assign D213 and D210A2 in WAB. Completed.
 - Dr. McKay will notify Geography of the approval to utilize room B208 in WAB temporarily. Completed.
 - Dr. McKay will notify Physics of the approval to assign rooms 101 and 101A in South College. Completed.
 - Dr. McKay will notify Ceramics of the approval to hold room M104 in WAB. Completed.
- 3. <u>Informational Item Only</u>: Master planning process update from Dr. Dunne.
 - Dr. Dunne provided an overview of building sequencing plans from the Master Plan in the near-term (within 5 years), mid-term (within 10 years), and long-term (20 years).
- 4. Informational Item Only: Update on campus construction projects and any corresponding surge plans.
 - Nursing Building: The building is almost completely razed.
 - Volunteer Boulevard Streetscape Project: The first phase near Joe Johnson Boulevard and Volunteer Boulevard should start sometime in October
 - Arena Renovation: All interior and exterior doors will be replaced
 - Surge Planning: In the process of securing off campus leases for some units
- 5. Review a request to rename the Communications Building.
 - A motion was made, seconded, and approved to rename the Communications Building to Communications & Information Building. There is no change to the building code; it will remain COM. Sarah Hoel will notify Barbara Tallent of the approval.
